# Morality or Immorality



With such emphasis on unbridled sex and loose morals in the movies, videos, television programs, advertising and music, is it any wonder that fornication and sexual immorality are looked upon as okay and acceptable. Most don't believe that those things are sins at all, and if they are, God winks at them. What does the Bible teach about sexual immorality of all kinds? And how does God view it? And what impact does it have on society? You might be surprised to find out what the Bible actually says. So let us discover the truth together.

## 1. What lead the children of Israel to forsake God and worship idols?

"And Israel abode in Shittim, and the people began to commit \_\_\_\_\_ with the daughters of Moab," (Numbers 25:1).

Whoredom is another way of saying sexual immorality.

#### 2. What was the result of sexual immorality?

"2And they called the people unto the sacrifices of their gods: and the people did eat, and bowed down to their gods. 3And Israel \_\_\_\_\_\_ himself unto Baalpeor: and the \_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_ was kindled against Israel." (Num. 25:2, 3)

16Behold, these caused the children of Israel, through the counsel of Balaam, to \_\_\_\_\_ against the LORD in the matter of Peor, and there was a plague among the congregation of the LORD. (Numbers 31:16)

Satan, through Balaam, used sexual immorality to lead the children of Israel into sin and false worship. He is still using this tactic plan today. Modern Balaams reminds us that "Sex Sells." As a result, it is impossible to turn of the television without seeing some half naked person gyrating on the

screen, using sexual innuendoes to sell products. If this wasn't bad enough, every avenue into the human mind is being bombarded by sexually explicit music, videos, films, literature and pornography.

What was sin in the past is sin today! God's law does not change and the wages of sin is still death.

#### 4. What should we do regarding fornication?

"\_\_\_\_\_\_ fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body." (1 Cor. 6:18)

The Bible uses the word "fornication" to represent all illicit sexual intercourse. It includes: adultery, bestiality, homosexuality, lesbianism, sexual intercourse with close relatives (Lev.18), sexual intercourse with a divorced men or women (Mk. 10:11, 12). The Greek word for fornication is porneia. It is where we get the word pornography. Fornication, therefore, also includes any viewing of sexual illicit acts, including the internet.

Notice it says, "Flee fornication." Never stop and try to figure out this sin. Run as fast as you can. King Solomon, warned young men against this sin. He said, "5...keep thee from the strange woman, from the stranger *which* flattereth with her words. <sup>26</sup>Her house *is* the way to hell, going down to the chambers of death," (Pro. 7:5, 26).
