

8.	Walk in God's truth together. "But if we in the light, as he is in the light, we have one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin" (1 John 1:7).
9.	Continue to rejoice with your wife. "Let thy fountain be blessed: and with the of thy" (Prov. 5:18).
